



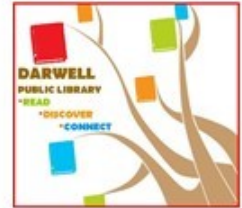

# Accepted Items

## **Accessories**

Hats, mittens, scarves, ties, socks,, purses, wallets, backpacks and bags

## **Clothing & Shoes**

Men's, Women's and Children's

## **Electrical**

Small electrical toasters, radios, power tools, irons, blenders, mixers, stereos, CD players, speakers, DVD and VCR players, table lamps, floor lamps humidifiers.

## **Kids**

Toys, games, puzzles and stuffed animals

## **Kitchen**

Pots, pans, utensils, china cups, vases, dishes, cutlery, glassware, silverware and stemware

## **Knick Knack**

Jewelry, crafts, mugs, candles, pictures/frames, baskets, ornaments and hand tools

## **Media**

Hardback and paperback books, magazines, records, tapes, CD's, videos, DVD's and computer software

## **Other Textiles**

Bed/Bath Towels, sheets, blankets, pillows, curtains and tablecloths

# Items Not Accepted

## **Automobile Parts**

Tires, Mufflers, fender, etc.

## **Beds and bedding parts**

Hide-a-beds, bunk beds, mattresses, box springs, waterbeds, coil springs, etc.

## **Construction Materials**

Lumber, pipes, floors, tubs, cabinets, carpets, doors, windows, etc.

## **Damaged Furniture**

Torn, soiled or in need of repair

## **Flammable products**

Any items that operate on or contain fuel including: gas cans, propane cylinders, barbeques, lawn mowers, weed trimmers, camp stoves, tiki torches, etc.

## **Hazardous materials**

Batteries, paints, chemicals, cleaning products, poisons, any liquids, etc.

## **Infant products**

Car seats, cribs and related products

## **Large Appliances**

Refrigerators, dishwashers, furnaces, stoves, washing machines, etc.

## **Marine vessels**

Boats, canoes, kayaks, etc

## **Televisions & Computer monitors**

Large televisions in cabinets, CRT "tube" televisions and monitors

## **Weapons**

Firearms, explosives, ammunition, flares, etc.
